Please watch out for an Electronic Voting Form, it will come to your inbox on 22nd October. Please ensure school have an up to date email address.

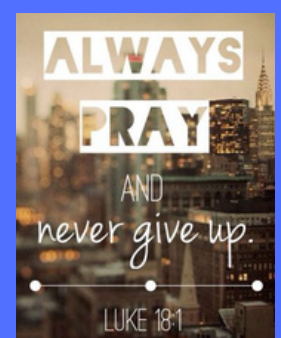
Votes will close at 12 noon on 3rd November.
