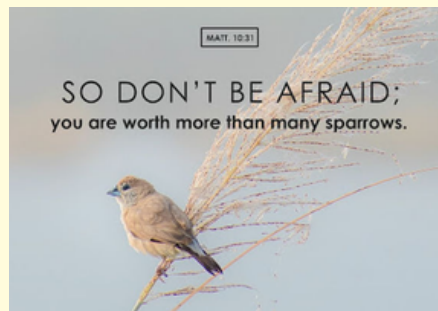
Gospel: Matthew 10: 26-33
