End of Year Reports & Results

Staff have been working hard to complete your child's End of Year report. We plan to distribute these reports on Wednesday 8 July 2026.

A short note about Year 6 SATs results: we were expecting the results on 7th July however, the Department for Education has now informed us that the national SATs results will be delayed and are due to arrive in school on 16 July 2026. Because of this, the Year 6 SATs results will not be included in the reports we send on 8 July.

What will be included on 8 July?

- Your child's End of Year report (teacher comments and attainment/progress summaries).
- Other assessment outcomes where available, such as Phonics Screening and the Year 4 Multiplication Check.

What will happen with SATs results?

- We will analyse the Year 6 SATs papers as soon as they arrive on 16 July and will share those results with Year 6 parents separately and promptly after our checks.
