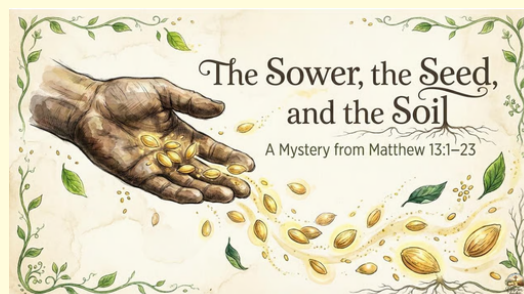

Gospel: Matthew 13:1-23

Sunday 12th June 2026 – the 15th Sunday in Ordinary Time.

In this gospel reading we hear about The Parable of the Sower. On that day, Jesus went out of the house and sat by the sea, and a large crowd gathered along the shore. He told the Parable of the Sower: a sower went out to sow seeds. Some seeds were eaten by birds, some fell on rocky ground and withered, some fell among thorns and were choked, and some fell on good soil, yielding a hundred, sixty, or thirtyfold. Jesus concluded, "Whoever has ears ought to hear", emphasizing the importance of receiving and nurturing God's Word.
