Plan a tea party on the moon for the aliens. Draw pictures of the food you want at the party. Will the alien like star biscuits, rocket jelly or moon cheese balls?

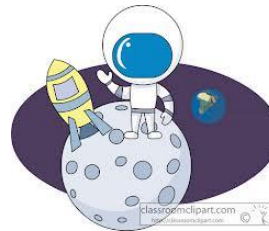
Design a planet. It can be as colourful as you like.
