

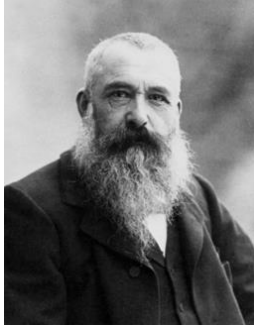

Monet struggled to make his living as an artist and it took until he was in his forties before his work began to sell.



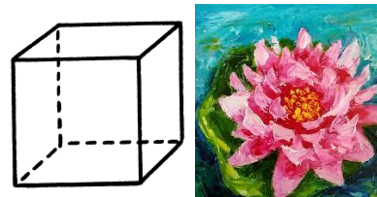
ELEMENTS OF ART

COLOUR

There are 3 primary colours: **red**, **yellow** and **blue**.
Mixing 2 primary colours together creates a secondary colour: **orange**, **purple** or **green**.

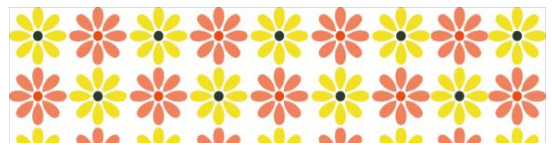
FORM

Form is a 3- dimensional shape. An illusion of form can be created in 2D artwork.



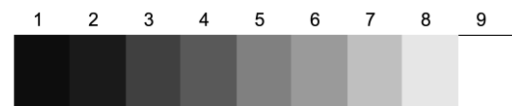
Pattern

A pattern uses a repeated design or a motif. Some patterns are man-made, such as the designs on our clothes. Some patterns are natural, such as the markings on a tiger.



VALUE

Value is the lightness or darkness of a colour.

Space

Space is the area around or between objects. Space includes the background, foreground, and middle ground.
