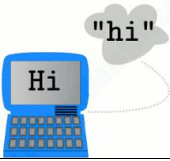

You will know how to use the touch interface on an iPad / tablet / phone. You may have read e-books with your family.

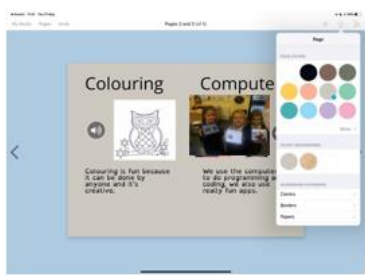
