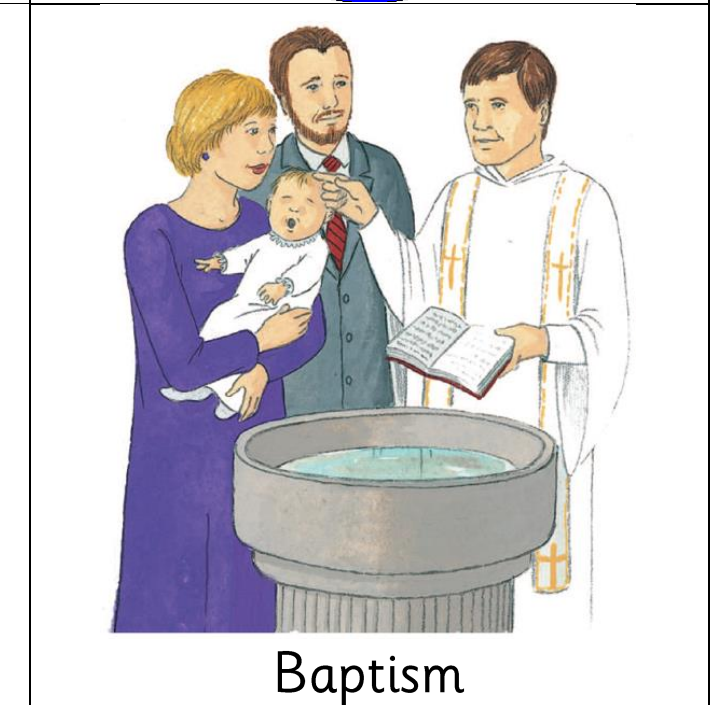
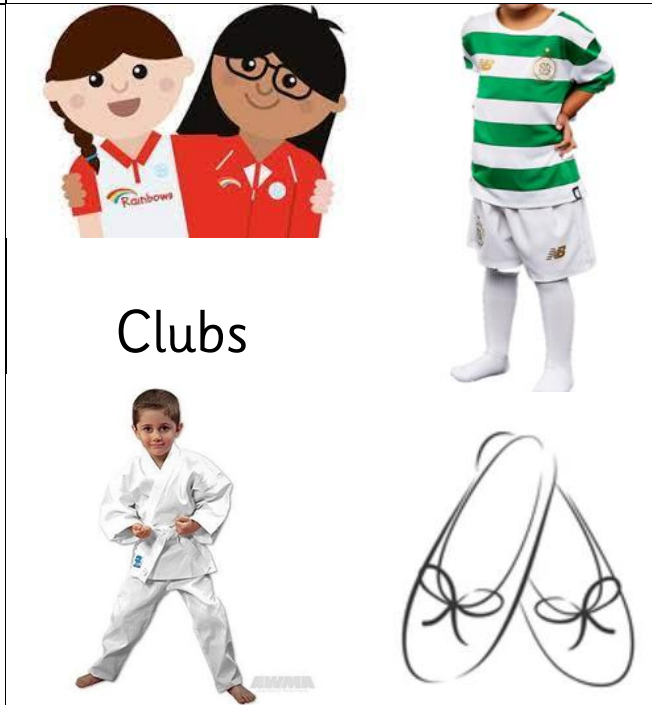
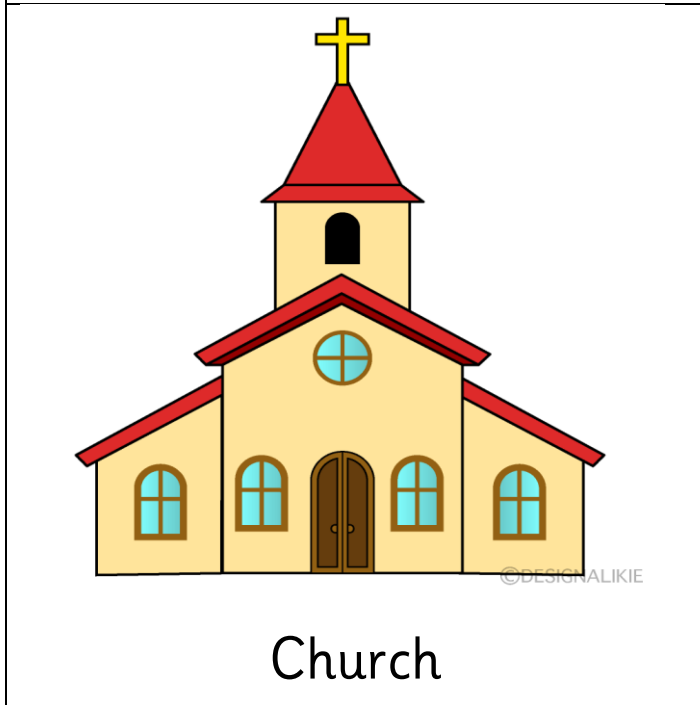


What does it mean to belong?
