At the end of the topic, I will know that: • The food, the people, the location and the reason for the meal can make it special. • The last supper is called the last supper because it was the last meal Jesus shared with the disciples. • Jesus told the disciples <i>"Take and eat. This is my body given for you. Do this in memory of me,,," Take and drink. This is my blood shed for you."</i> • The disciple ate bread and drank wine. • Jesus asked people to eat bread and drink wine to remember him. • The priest shares the bread and wine at mass. • Jesus gave us the Lord's prayer. • The Lord prayer is called the family prayer because we pray it as part of the parish family. • Everyone says the Lord's prayer at mass. • Holy communion is when the priest shares the bread (Jesus' body) and the wine (Jesus' blood) during mas.s • People who can't receive Holy Communion cross their arms and receive a blessing. • A parish community gathers together over meals to remember Jesus and to celebrate events and remind everyone to love one another.
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
