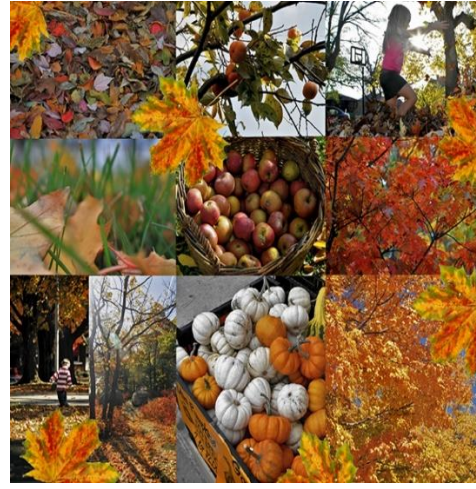

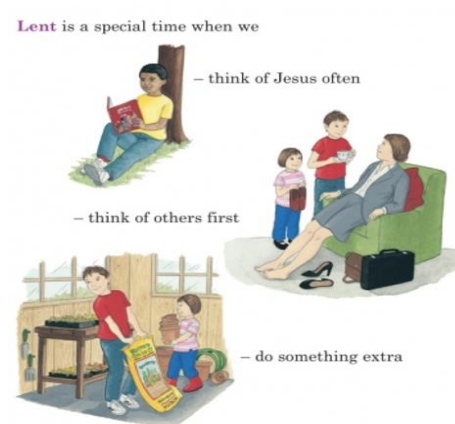

At the end of the topic, I will know that: • Lent begins on Ash Wednesday. • The ashes are made from the burnt palms from last year’s Palm Sunday mass. • Purple is the colour used in Lent. • God asks us to make a new start so we can be better in the future. • By forgiving people, teaching about the good news, and always trying to be kind. • The donkey was found tied up in a village near Jerusalem. • People waved palms and branches on Palm Sunday. • They spread their cloaks on the road. • We hear the phrase “Blessed be He who comes in the name of the Lord?” in church each week. • Jesus died on the cross. • Jesus asked God to forgive the people putting him to death, because they knew not what they did. • The women went to Jesus’ tomb to anoint his body. • They were surprised because the stone was rolled back. • Christians celebrate the fact that Jesus died to save us on Good Friday, and that he rose again on Easter Sunday.
