Keith Haring was born in 1958, in Pennsylvania, USA. He loved drawing cartoons and visiting museums.

Keith Haring is known for colourful, cartoon artworks and certain characters such as crawling babies, barking dogs and spaceships. .

When the paintings were sold, he often gave the money to children's charities.

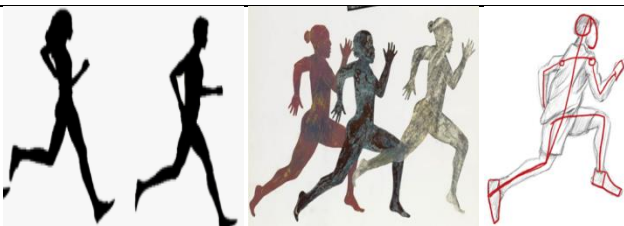
Haring, painted art with and for kids. He made murals in lots of children's hospitals and schools. He even painted a massive artwork of the Statue of Liberty with over 1000 kids!

He often listened to hip-hop music. Break-dancers used his pavement drawings as a surface for their performances.

Eileen Downes



Eileen Downes is a collage painter known as the artist who "paints" with bits of torn paper for a palette: she makes art from torn, recycled paper.



Vocabulary

Collage, layering, tearing, folding, crumple, overlap, shape, proportion, crepe paper, texture, sculptor

Proportion - describes how the sizes of different parts of a piece of art or design relate to each other

Media - pencils, rubbers, crayons, pastels, felt tips, charcoal, ballpoints and chalk

Palette - the range of colours used by a particular artist or in a particular picture

ELEMENTS OF ART

COLOUR

Primary colours.



Mixing two primary colours together creates a secondary colour.

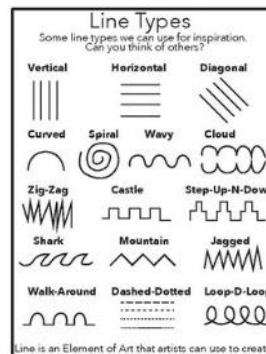


FORM

Form is a 3- dimensional shape. An illusion of form can be created in 2D artwork.



LINE



Space is the area around or between objects. Space includes the background, foreground and middle ground.

TEXTURE

Texture refers to the way something feels. Texture can be created in 2D artwork. (rough, smooth, etc.)



VALUE



Lightness or darkness
