For this half term, Year 4 will have their Outdoor PE Sessions on Wednesdays. Children should come to school in their outdoor kits on Wednesdays – please remember children should wear a white t-shirt for every PE lesson.

ENGLISH

In our English lessons this term, we will be studying Fairy Tales, Poetry and Newspapers articles.

Our class novel will be The Nothing to See Here Hotel.

Within our English lessons we will be covering Grammar skills, these skills will improve the pupils writing.

MATHS

In our Maths Lessons we will study the following:

Area, Multiplication and Division.

SCIENCE

This year we are following a new, exciting science scheme of learning from developing experts. Our topic is Animals and Classification.

During this topic the children will learn:

- Living things can be grouped in a variety of ways.
- How to use classification keys to help group and identify living things.

RE

In our RE sessions, we will be covering the topics:

Judaism

Being Called to serve God and help the Parish.

PSHE

In our PSHE Sessions, we will be covering the topic: Valuing Difference

The children will improve their knowledge and understanding of how and why people are different and what is good about being different.

COMPUTING

Our Computing topic this term will continue as: 'we are musicians'

The children will be planning and creating a micro:bit project.

HISTORY

This year we have introduced a new unit to year four which will look at Black History/ Local History with a direct focus on The Lancashire Cotton Industry.

ART

Our Art topic is to develop drawing techniques and use repeated patterns in printing.

The artists' work covered will be Damien Hirst's and Jean Basquiat's work on skulls.

MUSIC

Our Music lessons this term will be learning about the language of music through playing the glockenspiel.

PE

For indoor PE, the children will focus on dance. In the outdoor PE (now Wednesdays) the children will learn cricket off a specialist coach.
