Tourism		Tourism is when people travel to a particular destination to either relax and enjoy the different climate, explore new scenery or learn more about the culture in the area
Coast		A coast is a strip of land that meets the sea or the ocean. The UK is surrounded by the North Atlantic Ocean, the North Sea, the Irish Sea and the English Channel.
Weather		Weather is the short-term, day to day conditions of an area.
Climate		Climate is the long-term conditions of an area recorded over a longer period of time.
National Park		A National Park is an area of the countryside that is protected by law. The laws are in place to: make sure the history, land and wildlife of the area are protected, improve the area, give people the chance to enjoy and appreciate it.
City		A city is a busy settlement where people live and work. Cities were originally given their name by a king or queen, however today it could be because of the culture or the history of the area. Historically, settlements with cathedrals such as Wells and Salisbury became cities.
