ENGLISH

In our English lessons this term, we will be looking at the Titanic as a story and we also be studying The Lady of Shalott for our poetry element.

We will also be revising for SATs in both reading and grammar, punctuation and spelling

We will also look at debating and the rules associated with debates.

MATHS

In our Maths Lessons we will study the following:

SCIENCE

Our Science topic in Spring 1 is: Animals including Humans

During this topic the children will learn about blood composition and its function, the heart and circulatory system and how to keep our bodies healthy through diet, exercise and lifestyle.

- Increasing the heart rate
- How are water and nutrients are transported in humans
- Living a healthy lifestyle

RE

In our RE sessions, we will be learning about 'Witnesses' and answering the question, 'What do I want to witness in my life?'

PSHE

In our PSHE Sessions, we moving onto the topic of 'Being my Best' which looks at managing wellbeing and dealing with risky behaviour.

COMPUTING

Our Computing topic this term is: 'We are Publishers'. The children look at using a filming app and creating an advert.

HISTORY

Our History topic this term is The Mayans.

The children will learn who the Maya Civilisation was and how the landscape impacted them.

ART

Our Art topic will be Textile and learning how to create Batik pieces of art.
