ENGLISH

In our English lessons this term, we will be reading the Ingo by Helen Dunmore where we will be looking at lots of different writing genres.

Our grammar, punctuation and spelling will continue as normal.

We will also look at autobiographies paying close attention to various famous characters made famous for many different reasons.

MATHS

In our Maths Lessons we will look at a termly project called White Rose Tours.

The projects have been designed to explore maths in real life contexts, allowing children to see how important maths is in all aspects of life. As well as this there are cross curricular links, for example, including tasks that develop design and technology skills and geographical knowledge. The project also provides a great opportunity to explore and develop enterprise.

SCIENCE

Our Science this term will concentrate on investigations such as measuring shadows, dissecting a lamb's heart, creating shadows among other investigations.

RE

In our RE sessions, we will be learning about when people become sick and need care focusing on the Sacrament of the Sick.

PSHE
