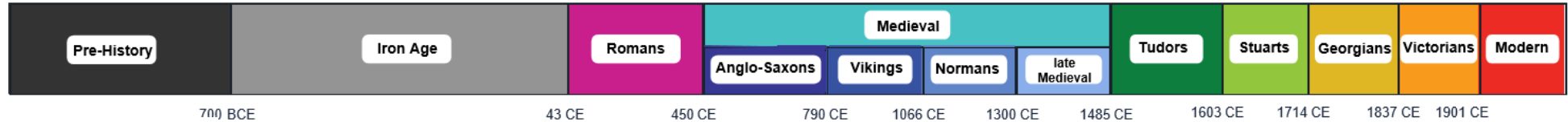

archaeologist	a person who studies human history and prehistory through the excavation
migration	To move from one place to another
tribe	a group of people, families or villages that share the same language, customs
Lindisfarne Priory	Historical landmark in Holy Island, England
heptarchy	a state or region consisting of seven autonomous regions
primary sources	Primary sources provide a first-hand account of an event or time period
secondary sources	secondary source of information is one that was created later by someone who did not experience first-hand or participate in the events
settlement	A village, a community, a place where people settle
civilisations	the society, culture, and way of life of a particular area
chronology	the arrangement of events or dates in the order of their occurrence
trade	the action of buying and selling goods and services
