	care	the provision of what is necessary for the health, welfare, maintenance, and protection of someone or something	
	compassion	a feeling of pity, sympathy, and understanding for someone who is suffering	
	forgiveness	a conscious, deliberate decision to release feelings of resentment or vengeance toward a person or group who has harmed you, regardless of whether they actually deserve your forgiveness	
	hospice	A program that gives special care to people who are near the end of life and have stopped treatment to cure or control their disease
